Concrete Repair

Nothing repairs concrete like RayCrete! Other concrete repair products have limitations on the size of the crack that can be fixed. It cannot be too deep or too wide (check out the products at Home Depot, a

typical limitation is about half an inch in either dimension). RayCrete has no such limitations. It can be used to patch and fill cracks of ANY size.

Brick Over Cracked Concrete:

Ask any mason what happens to brick façade when you lay it down as a walkway over a concrete crack repair and they will tell you that the brick will crack. Not so if you filled the crack with RayCrete! We have more than one testimonial where RayCrete was used to fill a large concrete crack and the floor was then bricked. Years later, the brick façade has yet to crack!

Gunite Pool and Pond Repair:

California is earthquake country and heat injected epoxy is the method of choice for in-ground pool repairs. You can expect to repeat this repair process at least every 5 years. RayCrete is now known to be a better repair product. Prepare the crack as you would for an epoxy repair (cut and clean), but use RayCrete to fill the cracks (color it to match your plaster). Unlike an epoxy repair, you will not need to fix that crack again!
